The Child Life Program was created to help children and families cope with a hospital experience.

Designed for inpatients and outpatients, Child Life aims to minimize the stress often associated with illness or injury, to enhance normal patterns of living, and to promote the child's optimum growth and development. Specially trained Child Life Specialists participate on the hospitals' multi-disciplinary health care team. They help children learn about the hospital, provide therapeutic play and support children through medical procedures.

What is a Child Life Specialist?

Child Life Specialists are trained professionals armed with a strong background in child development and family systems. Child life specialists promote effective coping through play, preparation, education and self-expression activities. They provide emotional support for families and encourage optimum development of children facing a broad range of challenging experiences. Because they understand that a child's well-being depends on the support of the family, child life specialists provide information, support and guidance to parents and siblings.

Endowment Terms

- As stated in the by-laws principal will never be touched, CMF will turn over 4% annually to the Child Life Program.
- The Board meets to ensure that the Endowment will be invested in conservative funds and will ensure the investment is safe.
- Should CMF cease to exist the endowment transfers over to the Northwell Health Foundation to ensure the endowment will live forever.
- Funds are solely to be used for the Child Life Program. Funds cannot be withdrawn for any other purpose or used for any other support of Cohen Children's Medical Center.
- Annual reports will be sent to donors and board.
